REQUIREMENTS FOR FIJIAN e-PASSPORTS:

We are now receiving appointments for Fijian e-passport biometrics registration. Email Second Secretary Mr. Ashneel Shankar on ashneel.shankar@fijiembassy.jp with your planned date and we will discuss that further – to ensure there are no clashes with others who have also made their appointment.

Please bring along the following when you come for the biometrics registration:

A. NEW PASSPORT APPLICATION

- Original Birth Certificate
- Valid Photo ID
- Marriage Certificate (for married women)
- Death Certificate if spouse has passed
- Deed Poll for any name change
- Adoption Papers if adopted
- Fijian Citizenship Certificate
- Fee – JPY30,000

B. RENEWAL OF EXPIRED PASSPORT

- Birth Certificate (Original or Certified)
- Your expired passport
- Marriage Certificate (for married women wanting to use their husband's surname)
- Official documents for any name change e.g. Deed Poll (please ensure Deed Poll is also registered in Fiji with Registrar of Births, Deaths and Marriages)
- Immigration (residency) status
- Fee – JPY30,000

- Applicants need to provide a copy of Citizenship Certificate if they're a citizen of another country.

- Applicants must also provide Immigration (Residency) status.

Service Delivery

Please note that the turnaround time for applicants to receive their new passports is approximately 3 weeks. Unfortunately, delays are expected due to the resurgence of the OMICRON variant of COVID-19.

All applicants will be notified via email on the progress of their application status.
